- 2. table (list) may not be cut off, unless if it is long, so that it is impossible to type it on one page. On the next page, the label (list), includes the number of the table (list) and continues, without a title.*
- 3. The columns are named and maintained so that the separation between one another is quite clear.*
- 4. If the label (list) is larger than the width of the paper, it must be placed on the left side of the paper*
- 5. . Above and below the label (list) a border is attached, so that it is separated from the main description in the paper.*
- 6. Tables (lists) are typed symmetrically.*
- 7. Tables (lists) with more than 2 pages or which must be folded are placed in the appendix.*

If the results are pictures, charts, graphs, maps, and photos, all of them are called images (not differentiated).

- 1. The picture number followed by the title is placed symmetrically below the picture without ending with a dot*

2. . *The picture may not be cut off*
3. . *Picture captions are written in vacant places in the picture and not on other pages.*
4. *If the image is painted wide along the height of the paper, the base of the image must be placed on the left side of the paper*
5. . *The size of the image (width and height) is attempted to be reasonable (not too thin or too fat).*

. The first part of the report, starting from the title page to the list of attachments, has been calculated with the page numbers using lowercase Roman numerals (i, ii, iii, iv, v, vi and so on). The number is listed only on certain pages that are more than one page. For example, certain pages that have more than one page, for example, for a table of contents that contains more than one sheet, the second page needs to be listed with page numbers in the previous order. The first page of this table of contents does not need to be numbered, but still counts. Likewise for the title page, validation and others, it is not necessary to include page numbers.

The main and final sections start from the introduction (Chapter I) to the last page, using Arabic numerals as page numbers (1, 2, 3 and so on). For pages with titles (new chapters) the page number is written at the bottom and is symmetrically centered, while for other pages, the page number is written in the upper right corner at a distance of 3 cm from the top and 3 from the right edge.

Page numbers are placed at the top right, unless there is a chapter title at the top of the page. For such a page, the page number is not included, but it is taken into account (there are but not written). Page numbers are typed with a distance, 3 cm from the right edge and 1.5 cm from the bottom edge

- b) Preposition. for example on, is often used inappropriately and is needed exactly like the words "where" and "of" in English in Indonesian, such forms are not standard and should not be used.
- c) The prefixes to and di must be distinguished from the prepositions to and di.
- d) Punctuation marks must be used appropriately
